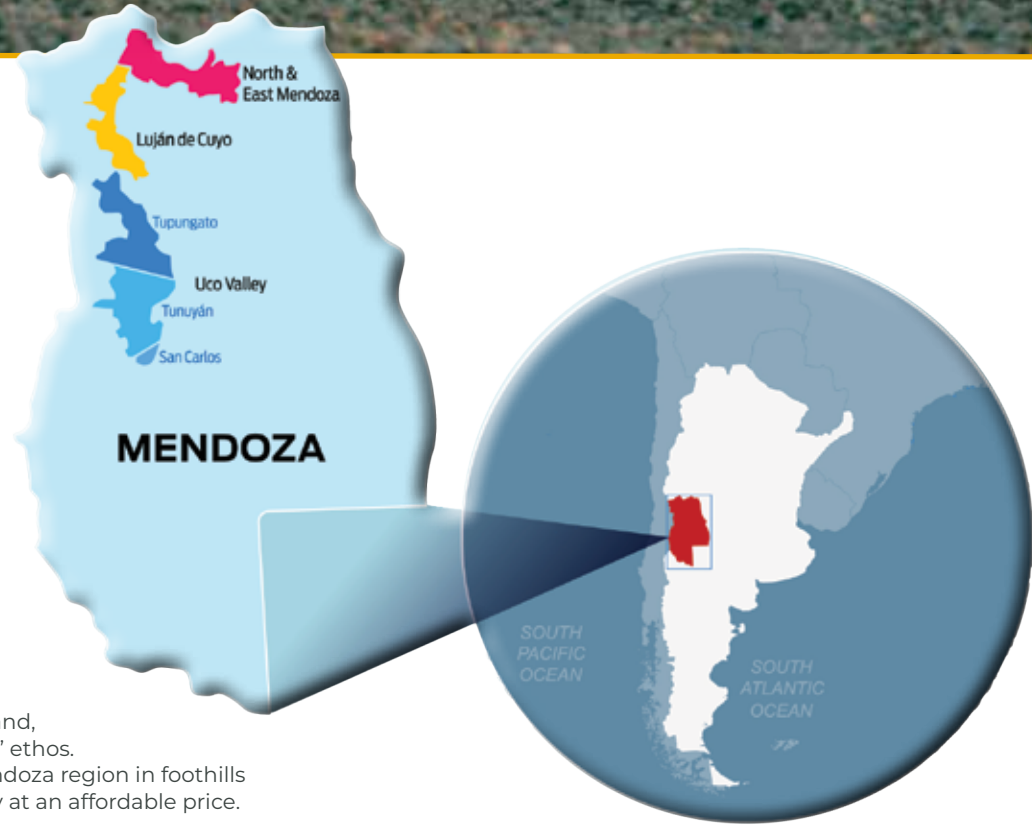
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Argentina

Argentina has a wine making history stretching back 450 years. With the exception of those of Rio Negro and Neuquem, most of the vineyards lie 600 metres or more above sea level and are grown on the lower slopes of the Andes.

La Bonita is our exclusive Argentinian brand, which embodies our 'from grape to glass' ethos. Wine is sourced exclusively from the Mendoza region in foothills of the Andes offering tremendous quality at an affordable price.

The wine is sourced from Las Perdices, a pioneer family winery in the Agrelo wine region. We ship the wine in bulk directly from the country of origin and bottle in the UK to reduce the impact on the environment.

More wine is produced in Argentina than in any other country on the continent. In fact, over 70% of Argentina's wines are grown right here in Mendoza, which makes it the sixth largest producer of wine in the world!



Meet our Producers LAS PERDICES

In the early 1950s, Juan Munoz arrived from Andalucia to farm grapevines. To him work is always more important than recognition and soil marks the rhythm of farm work.

In 2004, his sons decided to build a winery to produce high quality wines with great fascination for innovation. In April that same year, they founded Las Perdices in the heart of their vineyard in Agrelo where they grew up and learned how to make wine.

The winery has a capacity of 1,200,000 litres in stainless steel tanks of various capacities, in order to optimize processes and better distribute their finest products.



Australia

The first governor of New South Wales recognised the potential for wine making on his arrival in 1788. From the first plantings, vineyards have now spread to every state in Australia.

The transformation in the image of Australian wines has been rapid, it is now recognised in many markets as a significant producer of quality wines.

This has been the result of heavy investment, from both within and outside of the country in both the planting of vineyards and construction of wineries with the most modern equipment.

All wines are produced from estate owned vineyards and the family are privileged to be custodians of four centenarian old vine blocks in Southern Barossa Valley, the oldest dating back to 1897.

Explorers Shiraz

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Deepest dark red with vibrant garnet hue. The aromas are powerful and complex with a wealth of fruit. It has a rich and full palate with soft flavours of plums, mulberry and a hint of vanilla. This is complemented by spicy tannins and a long finish.

The mature Shiraz vines carefully chosen to vinify this wine are planted in two minute north/south oriented regions of Australia's Limestone coast, to the north Padthaway and 40km south Coonawarra. Great Shiraz at an outstanding value.

DARE TO EXPLORE...



Chile is South America's most important and largest exporter of wine, with a total of 118 000 hectares planted in Chile with an approximate split of 75% red varieties and 25% white.

Chile's unique geographical and climatic conditions offer it many advantages over other wine-producing countries. The country is very long and thin, some 4,500km from the Atacama Desert in the North, to the ice fields of Patagonia to the South, yet it is only on average 150 kilometres wide, with the land sandwiched between the high, snow-capped Andes Mountain range and the cold Pacific Ocean.

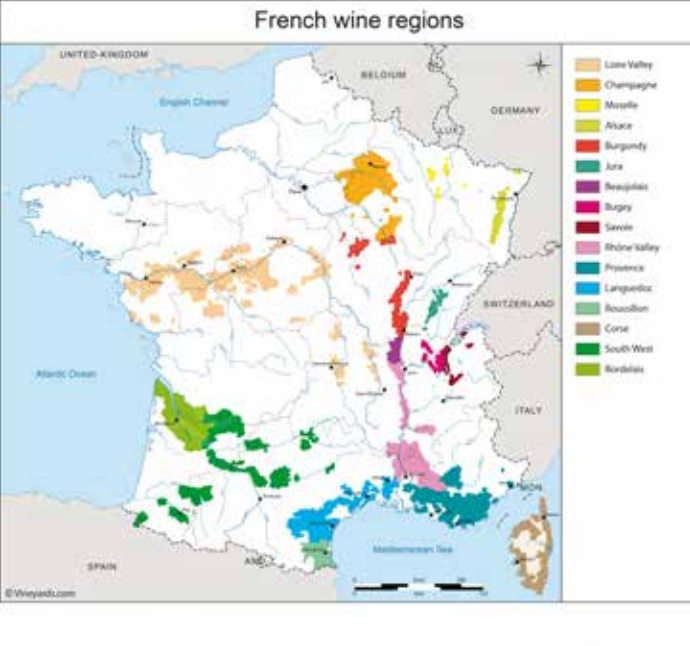

France today produces approx. 55 million hectolitres of wine per year and is regarded by many around the world as the leader in producing fine wine. More wine is imported into the UK from France than any other country and also accounts for approx. 1/4 of all UK imports. Appellation d’Origine Controlee (AC or AOC) is the highest level that a French wine can attain. Though the requirements may vary widely from one region to another, they are the most tightly defined. Few countries have such a long standing and developed wine culture as that of France and recognised to be amongst the best in the world.

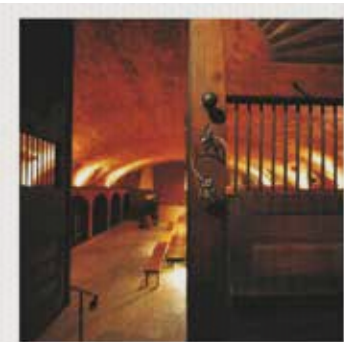

DOMAINES SCHLUMBERGER

DOMAINE SCHLUMBERGER

Now run by the 6th and 7th generations, Domaines Schlumberger was founded in 1810 by Nicolas Schlumberger, who established vineyards on the renowned slopes above the town of Guebwiller.

These vineyard sites have a history of viticulture, having been planted since 207AD. Through successive generations the holding has grown to be one of France’s largest and finest domaines.

Domaines Schlumberger now own 130 hectares of vineyards, 70 of which are Grand Cru. This makes them not only the largest owner of vineyards in Alsace, but also the largest owner of Grand Cru in the region. The vineyards include four Grand Cru sites which contribute to more than 50% of production.

In 2000, the family bought a second cellar because the first was no longer sufficient. Today, the Fillon estate has 35 hectares of vines including Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Sauvignon and Aligote.

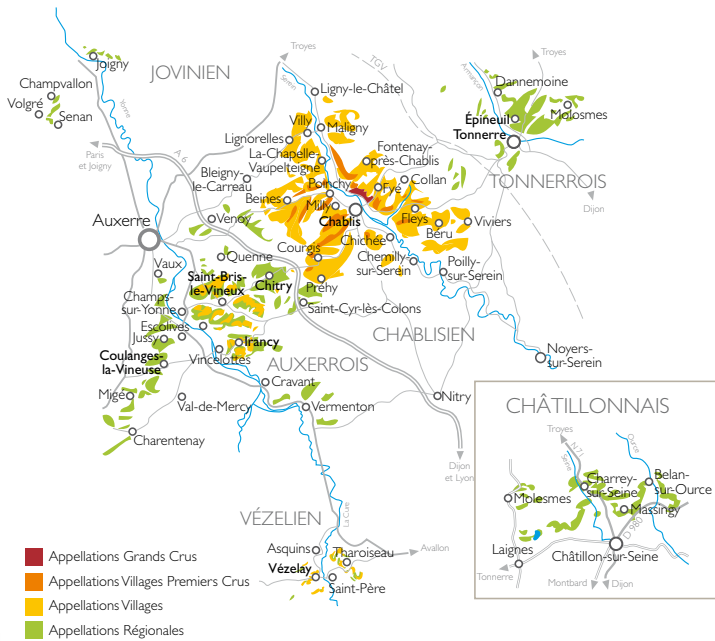

DOMAINE DE MOURCHON

Domaine de Mourchon was created by the Scottish McKinlay family in 1998. The vineyard had some 20 acres of mature vines but no facility to make wine so, using modern technology and high standards, a winery was constructed and completed in 2000.

The terraced hillside vineyard, at an average altitude of 350m is predominately clay and grey limestone which, combined with their micro-climate, gives the location a terroir of unique quality.

Careful husbandry using natural and organic techniques - 'agriculture raisonnée' as it is known in France - in conjunction with combined traditional and advanced methods of vinification results in a well structured wine with pronounced fruit aromas and strong colours. The wine of the Domaine now receive international recognition and praise.

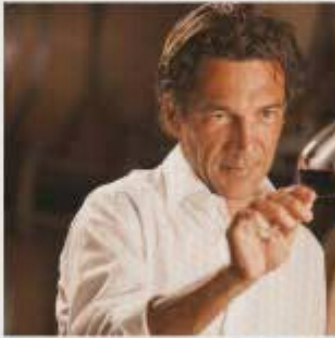
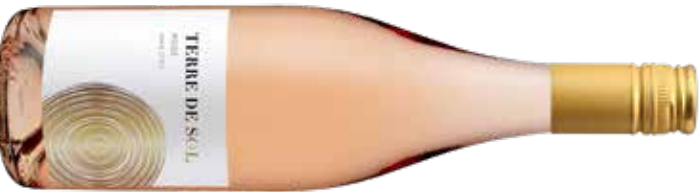

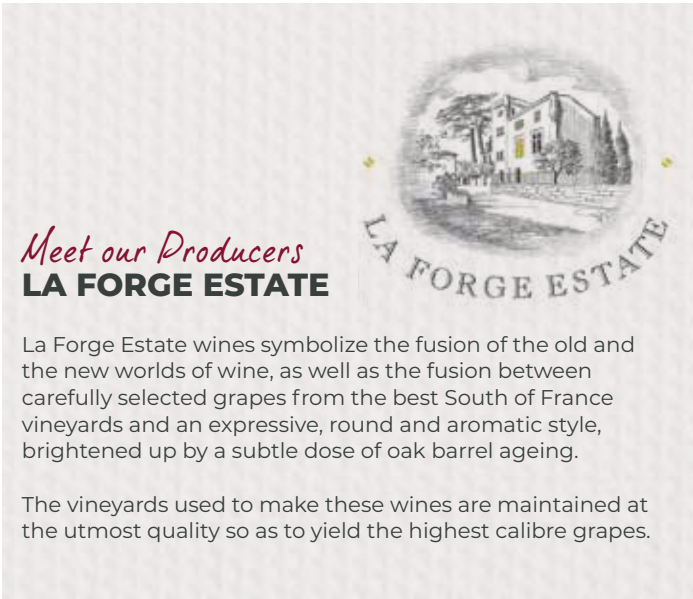

Italy, with an annual production of nearly 5 billion litres, is together with France, one of the two giants of global wine production.

Greek settlers introduced the vine to Italy as early as 800 BC and took to Italy’s rugged countenance with zeal. The Greeks christened Italy ‘Oenotria’ or ‘land of the vine’ and by the time the Western Roman Empire collapsed in AD 476 every modern European region of production, except Bordeaux, has been established.

Wine fuelled the excesses of generations of Roman emperors and Pliny, writing in the first century AD, introduced notions of the site selection and vine husbandry that remain relevant more than 2,000 years later.

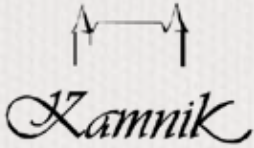

Spain

Spain has a long wine history, stretching back to Roman times with the country being a major producer. Since joining the European Union modernisation has come in a rush and this has happened not just in the vineyards and in the wineries, but also in legislation.

All is in a state of flux and to talk of the Spanish wine industry now is to take no more than a snapshot at a particular moment. Spain has a much larger area under vines than either France or Italy, but its annua production is much less than either of them.

This is because much of the vineyard area is still planted at very low vine densities, with vines that yield small crops due to the very arid climate and their old age.

Founded in 1870 by Mr. Vitorino, Eguren Ugarte is a family winery currently run by the sixth generation of men and women dedicated to the fascinating world of growing vines and wine making.

Thanks to this, they have managed to preserve many of the traditional wine making techniques and practices, as well as incorporating some of the latest technologies and techniques to enhance the wine making processes. All this results in exceptional wines that win major national and international awards.

They are located in the beautiful Rioja Alavesa, at the foothills of the Sierra Cantabria, surrounded by 130 hectares of vineyards, where they cultivate their philosophy of caring for the environment and sustainable wine growing

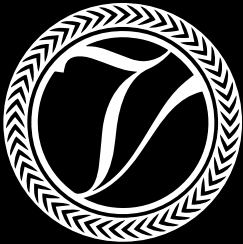

BODEGAS VALDUERO

Located in the village of Gumiel del Mercado, was founded in 1984 and was one of the pioneer wineries that formed the D.O Ribera del Duero.

The vineyards are among the highest in Ribera del Duero at an altitude of over 800 meters. The differences between day and night temperatures during the growing season, create the perfect conditions for fruit development. The low yielding vines are traditionally cultivated and only natural, organic fertilisers are used. Combined, these features create Valduero's trademark mix of fruit intensity with freshness, elegance and fine tannins.

Each of Valduero's wines are aged in cellars buried underground and this keeps them at a constant temperature that is perfect for ageing and helps to create unique and complex aromas.

CLOS MONTBLANC

The Clos Montblanc winery is located in Barberà de la Conca, very close to two symbolic locations in the history of Catalonia, the fortified town of Montblanc and the Monastery of Poblet. It is an area steeped in history and tradition.

Here the Cistercian monks settled, nearly a thousand years ago. Their ethos survives in the hearts of the local people today and can be clearly seen in the way in which they go about their daily work.

Clos Mont-Blanc create wines which have a unique character and a nature and sensitivity of their very own. Clos Mont-Blanc wines obtain their character from indigenous varieties such as Tempranillo or Grenache, together with foreign grapes such as Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon or Syrah, in a symbiosis of character & added personality. The white wines blend traditional Macabeo from Spain with Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc, ensuring the mix is exactly the right balance.

ATTIS BODEGA & VIÑEDOS

Since its inception in 2000, Attis has gained an almost cult-like status in Spain, recognised not just for the purity and complexity of their Albariños but also their ground breaking 'Atlantic Reds.'

The Farina brothers call the shots here, Robustiano and Baldomero, ably assisted by French oenologist Jean Francois Hebrand and the extended family, including Robustiano Jr. The 12ha estate is located in the Val do Salnes in the heart of Rias Baixas. The vineyards overlook the Arousa estuary and the Atlantic beyond.

The rhythm of the estate is of course dictated almost entirely by the ocean and no wine better encapsulates this than Attis Mar which was submerged in a (secret!) inlet and gently rocked by the currents for six months.

The roots of Champagne Volleriaux date back to 1805, when the Volleriaux family began cultivating grapes in the villages of Pierry and Moussy. In 1923, after the Great War, the ambitious young Victor Volleriaux, launched his own wine venture. His dedication and passion soon attracted a loyal clientele, and the business steadily grew into the celebrated Champagne house we know today.

Under the leadership of winemaker Franck Volleriaux, Champagne Volleriaux has become renowned for its "casual chic" house style - elegant yet approachable. His sister, H  l  ne, manages tourism activities, while their uncle, Jean-Marie, and cousin, Maurice, oversee the work in the vineyards.

In 2023, the estate was awarded House of the Year at the prestigious Troph  es Champenois ceremony, marking the 100th anniversary of their first bottling in 1923.

The most northern vineyard area of France, the Champagne region lies North-East of Paris, its heart in the form of a double fish-hook, with the valley of the River Marne as its shank. The three main vineyards concentrations are the Ballee de la Marne, The Montagne de Reims and the Cote des Blancs.

Champagne is a sparkling wine produced from grapes grown in the Champagne region of France following rules that demand secondary fermentation of the wine in the bottle to create carbonation. Some use the term Champagne as a generic term for sparkling wine, but the majority of countries reserve the term exclusively for sparkling wines that come from Champagne and are produced under the rules of the appellation.

Champagne Louis Roederer was established in 1776 and remains under the ownership of the Rouzaud family to this day. With over 240 hectares of vineyards located exclusively in Grands and Premiers Crus villages, Champagne Louis Roederer is self-sufficient for approximately 70% of their non vintage production and 100% of their vintage champagnes.

The house makes a range of champagnes starting with the classic non vintage Brut Premier blended from six different vintages from over 40 individual plots in a cuvée composed of 40% Pinot Noir, 40% Chardonnay and 20% Pinot Meunier. The champagne is made in a style that is refreshing yet with a satisfying depth of flavour. Since 2000, the house has been conducting trials with organic and biodynamic viticulture across 82 hectares and currently has the largest landholding of such vineyards in the region. The intention is not to gain biodynamic certification but rather to enhance the experimental approach of the house with the aim of continuously striving to improve the overall quality.

Sweet Wines are not fermented to dryness, the wines contain un-fermented residual sugar and they can be created in a number of ways. The UK's dessert wine market has improved dramatically in recent years.

New, more reasonably priced and innovative wines from the New World have meant that it is no longer only those wealthy enough to buy French Sauternes who can enjoy a glass of sweet wine with their dessert, Foie Gras or blue cheese. Sales of dessert wines in restaurants can be increased with minimal effort and without affecting sales in other areas.
